



ANTLER SHED HUNTING MATERIALS LIST

- Supplies you'll need to start
 - Storage container (large, unused 5 gallon bucket with lid or similar storage type container)
 - Supply of SHED antlers (3 to 6)
 - Antler silhouettes (3-6) optional but helpful for some dogs
 - Rack wax and/or liquid antler scent
 - Rubber/plastic antler(s) for initial practice
 - Whistle and lanyard
 - Survey tape for marking hides
 - Stay station (optional but helpful for dogs struggling to wait until cued)
 - Optional but helpful, field bell for your dogs collar and/or GPS collar and orange vest or harness
 - Make sure your dog has ID on them in case they wander off!!!
 - Orange clothing appropriate for your states regulations
 - Water for you and your dog
 - A dry nose takes in less odor
 - Towels to dry your dog after a hunt, as well as a brush to remove burrs
 - Snacks for your dog if they are searching for an extended period of time. If they are very young or elderly they will require frequent breaks with water and calories
 - Treats or a toy to reward your dog for a find
 - If you are searching in an unfamiliar area you will want to bring one or more of the following
 - Compass
 - Map of area
 - GPS system
 - Consider software to help you see the area, mark finds, navigate and track progress
